Pediatric Services Social Story





If I need to stay overnight at the hospital, I will go to the pediatrics unit. My parent will be able to come with me.



I will have bracelets put on my wrist.



I might move to a different bed.



A nurse will check my blood pressure.



The nurse will take my temperature.



The nurse will check my IV.



The nurse will put the light on my finger.



The nurse will lower my bed.
There will still be side rails on my bed.



The nurse will check me again and again.



I might be able to get a drink or some food.



A nurse will bring in a cart. They will scan my bracelet with a light before they give me medicine. This will not hurt.



The nurse might write on a whiteboard in my room.



I might get some lab work or an X-ray.



I will have a remote that can call a nurse and turn on lights.



There might be blinking lights or a sound coming from outside my room. This is okay.



I might be able to use the game cart or watch a movie.



I will get some sleep.



I will wake up and a nurse will check me.



I can get something to eat or drink.



I will move to a wheelchair or cart.
