McLaren Nurse Midwifery

The nurse midwife in our practice is a registered nurse who also holds a masters degree in midwifery with a special certification in nurse-midwifery.

While CNMs independently manage the care of healthy patients, they have 24-hour access to physicians, board certified in obstetrics and gynecology.

The practice philosophy is one of education and support for women, with a focus on wellness and consumer choice. The result is an added dimension of care for women and their families. Most insurance and Medicaid covers the cost of midwifery care.
